SPC Celebrates Arts Crush with Second Annual Page to Stage Showcase

Seattle, WA — September 1, 2010

In celebration of Arts Crush in October, The Seattle Playwrights' Collective (SPC) will be presenting its annual Page to Stage Showcase featuring ten short plays written by local Puget Sound region playwrights. With over forty participants including writers, directors, actors, designers, technicians, and volunteers, this event not only offers local playwrights a venue to showcase their work, but it also endeavors to provide a forum where numerous local artists can participate in Arts Crush.

The Seattle Playwrights' Collective Page to Stage Showcase begins Friday October 15 and runs through October 24. Performances are Fridays and Saturdays at 7:30 pm and Sundays at 2:00 pm. Tickets can be purchased through Brown Paper Tickets for \$18.00 and at the door for \$20.00. Both Fridays are designated "Date Night" Performances in which patrons can purchase two-for-one tickets. Reservations can be made for these two special events by emailing seattleplaywrightscollective@yahoo.com or by showing up at the door.

Funds raised during this production will be used to support local playwrights as they continue to pursue their craft through the many opportunities SPC offers.

An affiliated partner of Shunpike, the mission of the Seattle Playwrights' Collective is to promote the art of playwriting by providing local playwrights with workshop, reading, and production opportunities. In addition to the Page to Stage Showcase, SPC also hosts monthly workshop meetings at libraries in around the Seattle area and produces our monthly First Look reading series at Phoenix Theatre in Edmonds where playwrights can hear their plays read by professional actors and receive feedback on their work during chat backs with the audience.
